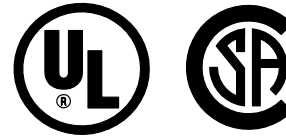


3M Grounding Connector 512G



Application:

The 3M Grounding Connector is a electrical spring connector designed for making ground connections and bonding non-metallic sheathed cable. The connector has a live action spring for strong reliable connections. It will electrically connect two or more solid copper conductors in a pigtail-feedthru application.

Solid copper conductors
14 to 10 AWG (1,5mm to 4,0 mm)

2 to 5 # 14
2 to 5 # 12
2 to 3 # 10
1 # 14 w/ 1 to 4 # 12
2 # 14 w/ 1 to 3 # 12
3 # 14 w/ 2 or 3 # 12
4 # 14 w/ 1 # 12
1 # 14 w/ 1 to 3 # 10
2 # 14 w/ 1 or 2 # 10
3 # 14 w/ 1 # 10
1 # 12 w/ 1 or 2 # 10
2 # 12 w/ 1 # 10

Spring	Spring Steel, Corrosion Resistant Plating
Insulator	Flame Retardant Nylon Color, Green

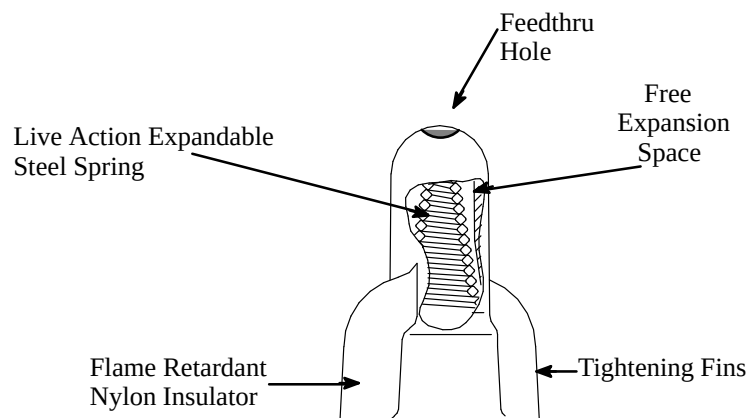
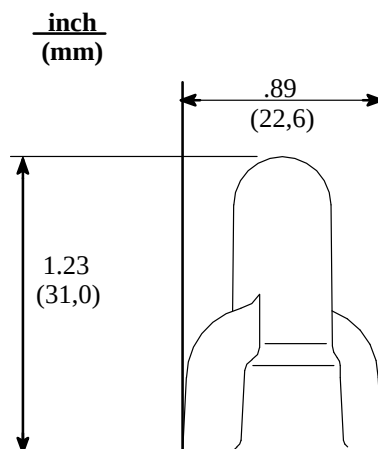

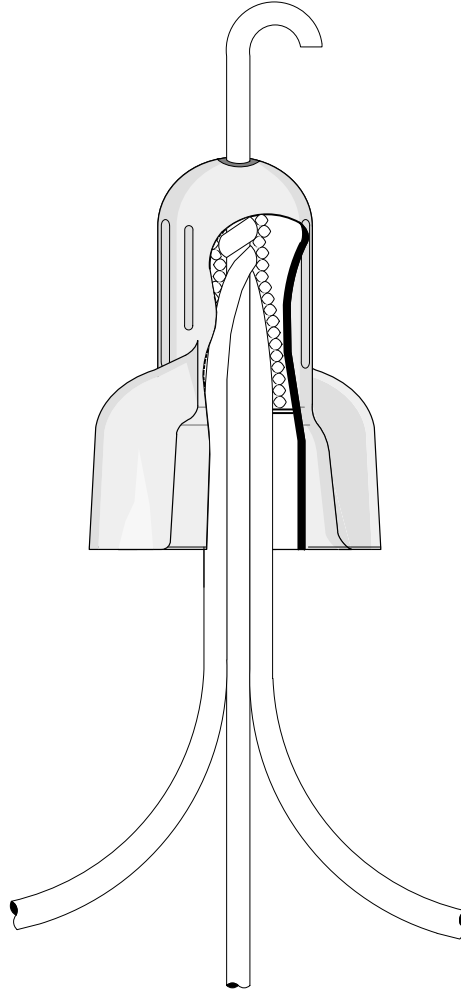

Installation Instructions:

3M Grounding Connector 512G

Caution: Turn power off before installing or removing connector. All electrical work should be done according to appropriate electrical codes.

1. Strip wires, if insulated, 5/8 inch.
NOTE: "Through" wire must be stripped full length.
2. Place "Through" wire in connector first.
3. Insert other wires into the connector in normal manner.
Wires may be twisted or untwisted.
4. Turn connector onto the wires in a clockwise direction until secure.
5. To remove, turn connector counter clockwise.
